PBL Focus Term 4 2019

As we begin Term 4 there are many things to consider with PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning) at Lalor Park PS. Firstly parents and carers need to be aware that we are constantly reviewing systems and the best practise to ensure that every child is supported by clear expectations and routines, both in their classrooms and in the playground.

One of the areas we are currently revamping is our wellbeing/behaviour procedures. We are revamping this in response to our recent parental consultation group meetings. Students who require time off the playground will now spend time in the lunch time reflection room. This will only occur when all classroom PBL reward and consequence systems have been accessed and further consequences are required. The reflection room is designed to give students a suitable consequence for their behaviour while providing an opportunity for self- reflection and executive counselling.

We encourage all our parents and carers to support this adjustment and be assured that this is a proactive approach. We now have a streamlined system where students in the reflection room are more engaged in their decision making and are encouraged to reflect on their own behaviour. It also allows an opportunity for the executive staff to better determine what the child needs to help them improve their overall learning. Indeed modern research tells us that when teachers, parents and carers establish meaningful and positive relationships with students/children then the chance of helping or redirecting a child to achieve positive outcomes is greatly enhanced. For Lalor Park Public School this is what our reflection room is attempting to do. If we accept that all students need consequences for their behaviour then it is imperative that these consequences are closely linked with opportunities to learn.

Please be assured that if your child does have to attend the reflection room they will be given guidance and clear strategies to help them become more capable learners. I thank you for your support and always remember that if you are worried about any aspect of your child's education your first port of call is always with their class teacher.



Bring a healthy snack, water and a hat for your child


