Dear Parents and Caregivers,

I write to provide you with an update about the Covid-19 situation and our school.

Next term, our school will continue with online learning from Tuesday 28th April. Please regularly check SchoolStream App for any further updates.

We have been preparing continuous learning for students to work remotely from home, through their learning packs. Teachers will continue to connect through Google Classrooms from 28/4/2020 with their students.

Don't forget that the NSW Department of Education website- **'Learning from Home'** hub provides information and resources for parents to support students who are learning from home. This is being regularly updated.

Our teachers will be communicating with student online using Google Classrooms throughout the school day but may not be able to respond immediately to students. They will inform students of how they will communicate and when. We would like our students to check in with their teacher and share their learning. Teachers will be providing feedback.

We also have many of our staff working from home on most days. As directed, we only have skeleton staff rostered on to work from the school site. As a result, your teacher may be making phone calls to you using "No Caller ID". If you receive a call from No Caller ID between 9am-3pm it may be your child's teachers.



Our school will also continue classes for essential workers and parents wishing to send their child to school; but there will be a number of staff changes. Students will be supervised completing their learning packs. No new or different material is presented at school.
